**Dates:** The May clinic will consist of four (4) 1-1/2 sessions during the following times/dates.  
Wednesdays May 1, 8 and 15 ~ 6-7:30 p.m. and Wednesday, May 22, 6-9 p.m.

**Location:** Lions Park: 3299-3201 Carew St, Fort Wayne, IN 46805 (meet at the picnic tables by the pavilion)

**Description:** This clinic will teach you not only how you can possibly 'win' a couple of 'free' points in a match by knowing the rules but it will help you feel confident in refereeing matches for fun and sometimes pay! This clinic is a full 7.5-hour clinic, which includes 4.5 hours of classroom training and up to 3 hours of practical training on the courts. During this clinic, you will:

- Learn how to score a match the correct way,
- Do the player orientation/briefing before the match,
- Conduct timeouts and keep control of the match.
- Of key importance, you will also learn how to recognize stacking and what to look for to recognize right side, right server issues.
- Videos may be used to supplement the instructor provided material.
- You will also learn line judging.

You will not be a certified referee at the end of this course but you will be a qualified referee. To be a certified referee, much more training and experience is required. This is your first step.

**IMPORTANT:** You must be a member of the USAPA in order to take this clinic. If you are not a member, you can sign up at the USAPA web site. It's only \$20/year for new members and comes with lots of benefits. Go to USAPA.ORG and click on **Membership/Donations**, then **Join the USAPA**.

**Who Should Attend:** Any level player or non-player may register. Those who want to know the rules better and those who want to know the basics of refereeing to help make pickleball tournaments successful. The number of sanctioned tournaments is increasing and every match needs referees. Becoming a referee will not only help give you an edge in your personal game, but will also give you an opportunity to give back to the sport to help it grow.
